The Jesse Derringer show was another great evening event! The pictures are worth a thousand words. This was our last scheduled show. All of those who attended this event had a fantastic time.

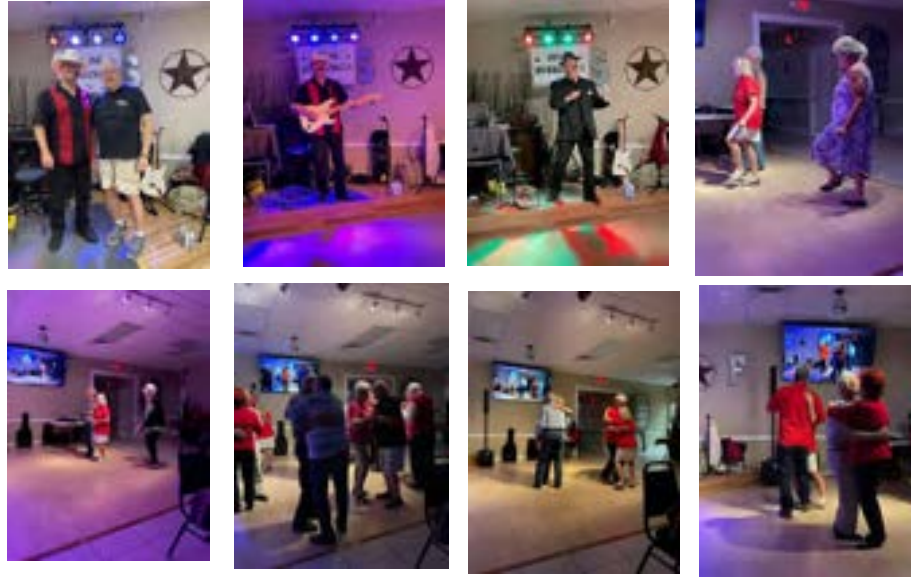
