Southfork has many new residents, many are also first time Florida residents, and may not be familiar with Florida estate planning and probate rules, R. Seth Mann is a practicing lawyer in Dade City and Zephyrhills, Florida.

Mr. Mann will focus his presentation on the common estate planning documents necessary to have in place to avoid both Guardianship and Probate as well as touching briefly on Medicaid. The documents he will discuss are as follows, Living Will, Health Care Surrogate, HIPPA waiver, Durable Power of Attorney, Statement of Burial Intent, Last Will and Testament and Revocable (living)Trust. Also, he will discuss the process of Guardianship and Probate and how to avoid both. Mr. Mann covers the common mistakes that he sees and issues common to clients that only reside in Floridan part of the year.

A little about Mr. Mann, in addition to his law degree, he is a CPA (certified public accountant) licensed in Florida and Virginia, He is a CFP (certified financial planner) Mr. Mann has a Master's in Business Administration (MBA) and a Juris Doctor Degree from Stetson University College of Law.

He has lectured in China at the prominent Zhejiang University School of Law on matters of international tax and business. He has taught at the U.S. Embassy in Thailand for the ASEAN Summit made up of Judges and Prosecutors of the 10 Asian member countries

Locally, he is President of the Pasco County Bar Association, President of the Florida Pioneer Museum, past President of the Kiwanis Club of Dade City, Treasure and Fund -Raising Chairman of the Pasco County Cattlemen's Association.
