## SPECTRUM CABLE UPDATE

As of September, we have 153 homeowners that are part of the Spectrum Bulk Group and their cable cost is \$49.82 per month. Everyone is saving a lot of money.

If you are interested please read the following guidelines:

1. If you live in the park **currently**, signups for Spectrum Bulk are done every 6 months. Our next sign up date is December 2021 with service starting in January 2022.
2. If you have just purchased a home here in the park, and the previous owner was part of the bulk program, you can join when you move in. The previous owner needs to return their equipment or they can take it with them to their new home, **but they need to notify me (Sallie Goodrow) that they are leaving and selling their home.** The new owners need to fill out informational paperwork so that I can notify Spectrum of a name change. Then they can pick up their equipment from Spectrum. They also need to make payments to our Achieva Checking account. All the needed information will be given to the new home owners.
3. If a new home owner purchases a home that is not part of the bulk program, they can start their service to Spectrum at any time, but cannot be part of the bulk program until December or June.
