The Last "I Love You" (Debbi Smoot)

Carol's husband was killed in an accident last year. Jim, only 52, was driving home from work. The other driver was a teenager with a very high blood-alcohol level. Jim died instantly. The teenager was in the emergency room for less than two hours.

There were other ironic twists: It was Carol's fiftieth birthday, and Jim had two plane tickets to Hawaii in his pocket. He was going to surprise her. Instead, he was killed by a drunk driver. "How have you survived this?" I finally asked Carol, a year

later. Her eyes welled up with tears. I thought I had said the wrong thing, but she gently took my hand and said, "It's all right, I want to tell you. The day I married Jim, I promised I would never let him leave the house in the morning without telling him I loved him. He made the same promise. It got to be a joke between us, and as babies came along it got to be a hard promise to keep. I remember running down the driveway, saying 'I love you' through teeth clenched when I was mad, or driving to the office to put a note in his car. It was a funny challenge. "We made a lot of memories trying to say I love you' before noon every day of our married life. "The morning Jim died, he left a birthday card in the kitchen and slipped out to the car. I heard the engine starting. Oh, no, you don't buster, I thought. I raced out and banged on the car window until he rolled it down. 'Here on my fiftieth birthday, Mr. James E. Garret, I, Carol Garret, want to go on record as saying I love you!' That's how I've survived. Knowing that the last words I said to Jim were, 'I LOVE YOU!"

Last Words of Love: There's a touching story about a woman named Carol who always made sure to tell her husband she loved him before he left the house. She recounts the last words she said to him before he passed away unexpectedly.

LHV Residents, I know of at least two times this month the ambulance has been in our park. No one has let me know any information.


Our residents deserve a card from the Sunshine Committee when they are ill, experience a death in the family or have other concerning life issues.



A Reel Good Time

In 2013, we started something really great at the Polk County Sheriff's office – we hosted the very first "Fishing with Judd" event behind the Sheriff's Operations Center in Winter Haven.

The idea was simple: bring in about a hundred or so children from across the county and have them fish with our deputies. On the surface that may not sound like much, but in reality, there's so much good that can come from such a common, wholesome activity.

Most of the kids had never fished before. Maybe their parent or parents work a lot of hours providing for their family, and they unfortunately don't have the time to take their child fishing. Maybe the family doesn't have enough money to purchase fishing equipment or have the transportation to take the child to a good fishing spot.

This year was our 12th year hosting the event and I really do think each year is better than the last.

The deputies and children found their spots around the lake, and the deputies showed the children how to bait the fishing rods, how to cast them, and how to reel a fish in. We try to make sure every child catches at least one fish, but it is not uncommon for some to catch several.

After we fished for several hours, it was time to eat. Sheriff Judd blessed the food and then the kids got some great burgers, hot dogs, chips, and cookies served by our deputies. The food was provided by Polk Sheriff's Charities, Inc, and prepared by our good friend Mike Wells.

Finally, each child was presented with a pretty nifty toy to take home (anonymously donated), and a brand-new fishing rod and reel provided by "Take a Kid Fishing, Inc." We know the kids had a great time and hopefully made lasting memories, but I believe my deputies and I are the ones who are truly blessed to be able to participate in this "reel" good time.




