Recipe Of the Month

Apple Cider Donut Cake (submitted by Linda Kelley)



Ingredients

For The Cake

1 Box Spice Cake Mix

34 cup Apple Cider

½ cup Cinnamon Apple Sauce

3 Eggs

2 tbsp Melted Butter

1/4 tsp Ground Allspice

1 tsp Vanilla Extract

Non-stick Spray

For The Cinnamon Topping

1/4 cup Melted Butter

½ cup Granulated Sugar

1 tsp Ground Cinnamon

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350
- 2. In a mixing bowl, combine the cake mix, apple cider, apple sauce, eggs, melted butter, allspice and vanilla extract using an electric mixer

- 3. Prepare a bundt cake pan with non-stick spray
- 4. Pour the batter into the bundt pan
- 5. Bake for 40 minutes (or until a toothpick comes out clean)
- 6. Allow the cake to cool completely for at least 30 minutes
- 7. Remove the cake from the pan and place it on a wire rack. A butter knife can help the cake pull away from the cake pan if needed.
- 8. Place the wire rack over a baking sheet
- 9. In a mixing bowl, combine the granulated sugar and ground cinnamon
- 10. Melt ¼ cup of butter and apply generously over the cake using a silicone basting brush
- 11. Sprinkle and press the cinnamon sugar topping over the entire cake. The excess will fall onto the baking sheet below the wire rack.

Notes

Store the leftovers at room temperature in an airtight container or tightly covered for up to 4 days.
