





New License Plate Law

On October 1, House Bill 253 went into effect, and it's important that Polk County drivers understand what it means. The law makes it a second-degree misdemeanor to have a frame, cover, or device that obscures part of your license plate. Violations can result in up to a \$500 fine and 60 days in jail.

The legislature has determined that license plate visibility plays an important part in making sure vehicles are properly registered, insured, and traffic laws are enforced. A license plate is one of the primary ways law enforcement identifies vehicles. If anything blocks the plate or the validation sticker, it interferes with law enforcement's ability to do its job. The law also prohibits devices designed to flip, hide, or switch plates, and even possessing one of these devices is a crime.

Selling or distributing them is a first-degree misdemeanor, and using one to commit or conceal a crime elevates the offense to a third-degree felony.

I know many people enjoy customizing their vehicles, and it's quite common to see decorative license plate frames with favorite teams or hobbies. As far as this new law is concerned, decorative frames around the outer edge of the plate are perfectly fine, as long as all the digits of your plate and the registration tag are completely visible. In other words, keep the information on your plate clear and unobstructed. Placing a tinted cover over a license plate also obstructs visibility.

Making sure vehicles are properly registered and insured is important. The new law's purpose isn't about punishing drivers for minor decorations, but about ensuring that plates are visible, legible, and detectable. This is also why it's also important your tag lights are operable. Visibility of license plates helps law enforcement solve crimes, recover stolen vehicles, enforce traffic laws, and protect the public.




