Ingredients

½ Cup Sugar

¼ Cup Flour

1 Envelope Flavored Gelatin

½ tsp salt

Blend thoroughly in a saucepan

Stir in gradually 1 ¾ cup milk

Cook over medium heat until moisture boils, stirring constantly. Boil for 1 minute. Place in a pan of cold water. Cool until moisture mounds slightly when dropped from the spoon.

Blend In: 3/4 tsp vanilla
1/4 tsp almond extract

Make a Meringue
3 egg whites
½ tsp cream of tarter
½ cup sugar
Add all to cooked mixture
Fold In ½ cup whipped cream
Add I cup shredded coconut if desired
Put in baked pie shell, chill several hours, top with strawberries & whipped cream.
