Use the cue stick to strike the white cue ball, aiming it to hit other object balls. The general goal is to sink your assigned balls before your opponent, or score points through specific shots, depending on the game. Stick cues are available to use in the clubhouse, if you don't have your own.

BINGO

A game of chance in which each player matches the numbers printed on different arrangements of cards. Don't have your own supplies, no problem, supplies and cards are available for sale before the games begin.

BIRTHDAY & ANNIVERSARY

Each month enjoy cake with residents celebrating their birthday or anniversary. Everyone is welcome.

CLR

A popular game where players pass dimes or chips left, right, or into a center pot based on a dice roll.

COFFEE & DONUTS

Enjoy relaxing conversation with fellow residents. Bring your favorite coffee mug and \$1 if you'd like a donut.

CORNHOLE

A game where players toss beanbags at an angled platform with a hole, aiming to score points by landing bags on the board or in the hole, with the first team scoring 21 winning.

CRAFT CLASS

Whether you're a crafter or want to be, enjoy a few hours each month working on a pre-selected craft project led by a current resident.

DIABETES SUPPORT GROUP

If you have been newly diagnosed or have years of experience with diabetes, share your experience and knowledge with others at this monthly group.

DOMINOS

A tile-based game played with rectangle pieces, placing tiles end-to-end matching the number of dots on each tile.

EUCHRE

HOT DOG ROAST

LHV provides the grilled hot dogs, residents fill in the blanks. Bring your favorite dish or dessert to share with your neighbors at this monthly event.

LADIES LUNCH

MEN'S BREAKFAST

PAINT CLASS

PINOCHLE

A classic American trick-taking card game using a special 48 card deck. Players bid for the right to call trump and score points by melding card combinations.

POKENO

First released in 1930, this game is a combination of poker and keno (or lotto) and is similar to the game of bingo in several aspects. This game is played with 2 to 13 players.

POKER

A card game played worldwide, where players wager over which hand is best according to that specific game's rules.

SASSY STITCHERS

Bring your sewing machine or reserve one from the current resident who will lead you through creating a fun project for a nominal fee.

SHUFFLEBOARD

An outdoor game using a cue to push weighted discs down a long court, aiming for marked scoring zones. Rules involve strategy, knocking off opponents' pucks, and reaching a set score. Weather permitting.

WATER AEROBICS

Weather permitting. Improve cardiovascular fitness, muscle strength, balance, and flexibility with this form of aquatic exercise performed in the pool. The water's resistance allows strength training without heavy weights, while its buoyancy reduces stress on joints, making it a low-impact option.






